




Hello Everyone and welcome to the Cherry Tree Lane newsletter.

During our Recovery Curriculum, we read a range of stories about how resilience and perseverance can help when faced with tricky situations. During the year, we will continue to refer to how the book has taught us that we can stretch and grow our brains through our learning.

The children have also taken reading and maths assessments so that we can find out what needs 'catching up'. I know how keen they are to make up for any lost learning.
