I hope you have all had a lovely Half Term! Are you ready for Term 4?

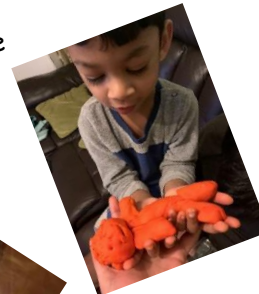
Last term we were learning all about the **Numbers 1- 5**; we have explored what they look like, how we can make collections to represent those numbers, and what it is to subitise.

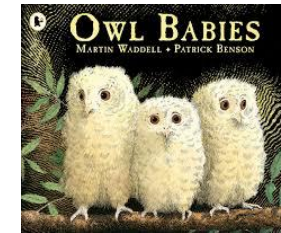
