Choose a festival that interests you, find out what the festival is about and how it is celebrated. Create a poster to share your findings.

Mindful Listening

Go for a walk (make sure your adults know where you are) and stop. Listen carefully and see what you can hear. How many different sounds are there? Do they change? Are they loud or soft? Are they high or low pitched? Which direction do they come from?

Art

Using the skills we have learned about using colours and shapes in art, create your own version of a rainforest scene, including an animal. Use Henri Rousseau's work for your inspiration. You can create your work on Purple Mash, using 2Paint or 2Paint a Picture, or on paper with drawing and paints or pastels.
