


Supporting your child at home

Reading books - please read with your child at home at least **5 times** a week. We are fast approaching the phonics screening test so please keep reading with your child as it will help a lot.

Sharing Stories- please share and discuss a book with your child regularly to encourage reading enjoyment. Here are some great books related to our 'Explore, Invade, Conquer!' topic.



Spellings- children will receive spellings on a Friday to be tested on the following Friday. Your child will receive a certificate every Friday to celebrate their results. We have seen an improvement in spellings across the year group so please keep this up. 😊

Homework Grid- Your child will receive a homework grid for each new topic. Please choose **at least 3** activities to complete and share in school at any point during the topic.
