All adults and children in Y1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 must wear a facemask on the school playground in a morning and when leaving at the end of the day

Adults dropping or collecting Nursery or Reception children must wear a facemask but children do not need to

All staff will be wearing a facemask at these times but not in the classroom when teaching



The playground will have a One Way System. **Please enter on Avening Street and exit at the Park**

Teachers will be waiting for your child from 8.30am to 8.40am. Please, do not be late.

The school gates will be closed at 8.50am


The school Reception will be closed with only telephone and email being answered



Social distancing must be in place at all times

Please do not stay on the playground once your child has been dropped and/or collected

Keep your children with you at all times they must not mix with others on the playground



There will be **no Walking Bus** until further notice

There will be **no after school clubs** until further notice

There will be **no Friday afternoon care** until further notice

Each class is one bubble. Throughout the day all children will remain in that bubble. They will not mix with any other bubbles and the adults, will also remain within the one bubble.



Your child **only** needs to bring to school their;


Small wallet/bag for a facemask Book bag coat
